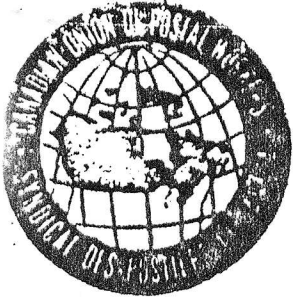

' THE OINK AWARD '

* SUPERVISOR OF THE YEAR *

The Canadian Union of Postal Workers, Ontario Regional Office has decided to present an award to the Supervisor of the Year.

The name of the award is to be called 'THE OINK AWARD'.

It will be presented to the supervisor who is best described by the word oinker.

To be eligible a supervisor must have, during the past year:

- 1) Denied at least 1 Special Leave Application.
- 2) Counselling a Postal Worker for Attendance.
- 3) Counselling a Postal Worker for Poor Work Habits.
- 4) Counselling a Postal Worker for Being Away from the Work Area.
- 5) Counselling a Postal Worker for Insubordination.
- 6) Recommended at least One Suspension.
- 7) Sent 1 Letter of Reprimand.
- 8) Harrassed a Member of the Bargaining Unit.
- 9) Recommended that a Position Become Surplus.
- 10) Proved To Be Incompetent.

There is no doubt that most supervisors will be eligible for the award, and most Locals will have a difficult time nominating just one for this most prestigious award.

Locals should send to the Regional Office, the name of the supervisor they wish nominated, and describe in 50 words or less the atrocity which she/he committed.

Closing date for nominations is January 1, 1985.

Judging will take place at our next Regional Union Education & Grievance Committee meeting, scheduled for early in the New Year.

A bulletin will be sent to all members, with a list of the nominees and the name of the winner as soon as the judging is completed.
