The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposed move of the Ajax and Pickering operation at 710 Progress Avenue to the Ajax Post Office.

The Union expressed their concerns as to why the proper consultation process was not followed as in their opinion this matter was the proper subject for Regional consultation.

Management informed the Union that it was their understanding that Regional consultation was only required when dealing with Article 14:02 (c), and since the move did not change the employees' schedule, it was felt that it did not apply. However, local consultation was requested and the Union declined, therefore, Management informed the Union that they were proceeding with the move.

The Union requested that any arrangements made for the move to date be rescinded and that they be provided with all pertinent information as to reasons for the move, volume counts, etc.

Management agreed to this request and information would be forwarded to Mr. Alviano's Office by Thursday morning the 9th December, 1982.

The Union strongly advised Management that Articles 13:04 and 13:07 be adhered to in the implementation of the move, even at the risk of overstaffing.

Management to seek further advice on this matter and inform the Union.
